



### Contents:

- 24 ladybird cards
- 1 dice shaker
- 1 dice



### Object

To collect the most ladybirds.

### To play

- Spread out all the cards, with the dots face upwards, on the table.
- The youngest player begins by throwing the dice and choosing a card with the same number of dots as shown on the dice.
- The player turns the card over to show how many ladybirds are hiding on the leaf. The player then keeps this card. N.B. Some leaves have no ladybirds on them.
- Play passes to the person on the player's left.
- Towards the end of the game, players may not be able to find a card with a matching number of dots. In this case play passes to the next player.
- The game ends when all the cards have been taken. Players must then count how many ladybirds there are on their cards.

### The winner

The winner is the player with the most ladybirds at the end of the game.
