







This set contains one frame and 42 chips.




If playing with two players, one uses the red and the other uses the orange chips.


If playing with three players, one uses solid orange, one uses solid red and the other uses the chips with a hole in it.




The youngest player starts by putting one of his chips in the frame. Your turn ends after you played one chip. Now it's the next players turn. He can put one of his chips on top of the other chip or put it somewhere else.



The object of the game is to be the first one who has got 4 of his chips in a row. Rows can be horizontal, vertical or diagonal.



When all the chips are put in the frame and no-one has 4 in a row, it is a draw and you have to start over.



As a variation; play best out of 5 or organise a tournament!
